



Child Development Centers Serve as the Hands & Feet of IREF's Mission

In the state of Andhra Pradesh where IREF schools, churches and child development centers (CDC) are located; Christians make up less than 5% of the population. Over 90% of the more than 84 million inhabitants of the state are Hindu. Andhra Pradesh is known for its lower population density and serves as mainly an agricultural state. With a majority of the rural population in Andhra Pradesh living in small tribal villages, literacy rates become problematic ranking last in India at less than 67%.

IREF has worked for over 60 years to reach this population with the love of Christ and also the opportunity to read and write. Many children and parents come to know the Lord through this connection with an IREF CDC. It is at this point that CDC teachers and leaders help plant the seed in families to continue their education at the IREF campus in Repalle where Christ will be undoubtedly the focal point of their education.

For any family in Andhra Pradesh, education is a hope and a dream. Too often educational institutions are too far from these tribal villages for children to attend and parents are too poor to transport them. Many times parents will

take the child to work with them to earn higher wages. IREF currently operates nine Child Development Centers that focus their efforts on the surrounding tribal villages outside of Repalle where the IREF main campus is located. The continued support for each CDC is critical to the mission of IREF as the tribal villages are ultimately the communities that our mission aims to serve. Our prayer in 2015 is that God will continue to grow the impact that IREF has through each Child Development Center and that Christianity would spread through the hearts and minds of all who attend.

Tribal villages that surround Repalle are where the true mission of IREF was intended to serve. These small rural farming and fishing villages are crying out for any hope of prosperity for their families and what a better way to feed their soul than with the message of Christ's love. Emmanuel Rebba commented on this planned refocus for 2015: "the IREF campus is a comfortable place to serve God and there is a great Christian Community supporting each other in Repalle. But that community can and needs to be extended into our IREF villages where the real battle for souls is taking place. Tribal villages are predominantly Hindu and I know God wants us to take His message of Hope to them."

John, Emmanuel and Dee Rebba along with IREF pastors facilitated a 3-day revival meeting in each of the villages of Nagaram and Bobbaralanka. These revival meetings will continue for the next two months in multiple locations as Emmanuel Rebba has planned to focus efforts on villages that IREF churches & Child Development Centers have been planted.
