Looking back at all the stories of redemption and changed lives, many children can credit only one God for everything they have in their life. In times of struggle, God has encouraged these children. In times of desperation, God has protected them. In times of extreme fear, God fulfilled His promise to save them from their enemies. Reading their stories is a constant and real reminder of His love for this remote region of the world.

Divya Chandana - My story starts when I was 6 years old after my mother died with tuberculosis and my father abandoned our family. Our neighbor brought my younger brother, Preetham and I to IREF to be cared for and it is IREF that has been our home ever since. IREF is where we make our home all year round as we have no where else to go and no one else to care for us. I enjoy playing with my friends here at IREF and I am now in 5th class. Many students here at IREF have similar stories to the one I am telling you today. We have a love from Jesus Christ that encourages us daily and we get to hear about how He is working to provide all of us with a hope and a future. Jesus is my only hope!

Sai - My story starts when I was a little girl and my family caste/occupation was prostitution. According to the caste that I was born into I was expected to also become a prostitute. My mother and father both contracted the HIV/AIDS virus when I young and I went to live with my aunt (after my father died). She heard of IREF and brought me here to get an education, but I never expected I would have my life changed so dramatically. While at IREF, I accepted Jesus Christ as my personal Savior. I also finished my degree in science and am now working in an eye clinic in the city one hour from IREF. I am able to provide for my family with the job God has given me and I have been able to break the expectations that my caste has for my life. Without the power of Jesus Christ my story today would have been much different. Praise God for His perfect plan!

Parvathi - My story starts in 2009 when I was brought to IREF by an evangelist from the city of Guntur. I was brought to IREF under very secretive and confidential conditions. You see my uncle kidnapped me when I was in high school and sold me to sex traders that were seeking to transport me and 49 other children to Thailand. The sex traders needed to move us in order to elude the authorities. At that point I was able to escape. I was brought to IREF for safety and for a chance to get my undergraduate degree. By God's grace, I was able to finish my education there in 2012. I am now married to an evangelist and we both plan to be serving at IREF starting in June 2015. Praise God for His saving Grace!

Children who would otherwise be destined to a life of poverty are being given the tools to change the pattern. They're being given a foundation of faith and a mind of knowledge, inside and outside the classroom. They're getting an education that is a crucial component in breaking the cycle of poverty that has afflicted their families for generation. The presence of Christ changes lives, and IREF is doing all it can to bring that spirit of Christ to as many people as possible.
