Annual Survey Data of Returning Students

shows evidence of God's work being completed at IREF. Every year upon their return, college students are randomly selected to answer some brief questions surrounding their time spent on summer break and their hopes for the future year at IREF. This year 41 college students were surveyed and the is data analyzed to discuss improvements IREF could make to further foster a sound educational and spiritual environment for the children to grow and develop.

For starters, each child was asked what religion is practiced at home and survey data on 41 children showed that 10 children came from Christian homes, 18 children came from Hindu homes and 2 came from Muslim homes. Then, each child was asked how consistently they were able to read their Bible. The response varied with many children stating that they did not read their Bible as much as they did while at IREF. Ironically, when each student was asked what they looked forward to upon their arrival back to IREF, they responded that they looked forward to being in church on Sunday mornings and to hearing the Message in evening devotions. The last question revolved around what each child hoped to gain in the coming year and unanimously every child wished for good grades or marks.

When considering the responses many children gave to these questions there are many conclusions that can be drawn. At IREF, the main mission is to ensure each child is able to build a strong relationship with Jesus Christ. Education is used as a vehicle to mold minds and encourage development and growth. God's promises are the means by which each child is able to take themselves out of the grips of life's circumstances and crave a relationship that will elevate them through life's struggles. IREF would expect that in the current cultural climate each child would want to succeed and get good marks. However, one thing that is not shared culture-wide is a relationship with Jesus Christ and we gauge that by each students desire to be involved in worship. IREF is encouraged by this year's survey data and how many children expressed their desire to worship upon return to IREF.
