Reopening Updates The Indian government is expected to re-open schools starting Monday, November 2nd. However, we are also aware that this date might be pushed to a later date. Until that time, IREF continues to make the schools and the campus ready for students. We are committed to child safety by instituting safety protocols, abiding by safety policies the government mandates for each school such as classroom seating arrangements, installing hand-washing stations throughout the campus, and providing mandatory masks for each student to name a few. Because of the fluidity of information regarding re-openings, we will uphold guidelines provided to us by government, as well as doing our part to make the students and staff remain as safe as possible with our own policies.

Please remember the students of IREF in your prayers during this time. Below are a few prayer requests:

- The students long to return to IREF and continue their education.
 Many of the students miss their friends and the stability that IREF offers them.
- For the Christian students, they are surrounded by Hinduism in their villages. Pray that God would give them strength to stand for Christ.
- Some of the students are at risk for child labor, poor living conditions, and home abuse. Pray God's protection over them.

Our IREF-India staff call the students weekly. During these calls, the staff check in with the student, encourages them, and provides over the phone tutoring. We are thankful for the staff's dedication to the students, and pray that the students will be soon returning to IREF. Please pray with us as we navigate this pandemic once students return to campus that we learn to adapt so that we can provide quality education to students.

Covid Testimonial "My brother and father both tested positive for Covid in late July. My sister in-law also got it shortly after. We were all so worried. I live in Vijayawada about 2hrs away from my brother, Lawrence (*IREF Pastor*). We couldn't even go visit or help them due to the shut-down. During the same time my husband, who works in a bank also contracted the virus along with a few of his collegus. My husband was picked up by our health department and taken to a quarantine facility. My children and I also ended up with mild symptoms and had to strictly quarantine in our home for two weeks. Our neighbors were afraid to come near us, the stigma of Covid was overwhelming. My only help in time of need, came due to PRAYER. I started praying like Daniel did three times a day. Joshua 1:6-9 guided me through the difficult time. God sent us help through friends who showed compassion and bought us milk, water and a few groceries. Pastors Conferences Resume After some time of prayer and discussion, IREF-India felt it was time to step out to begin ministering again. For months, IREF has been on hiatus from in-person evangelism, using Sunday service and electronic media for primary forms of sharing the Gospel. With precaution, IREF gathered Pastors from a region 3 hours away on October 7th, to hold its first pastors conference since March. Masks, sanitizer, temperature checks and individualized napkins were a few of the safety measures were followed.

Emmanuel's message was based on the theme of spiritual awakening; reviving local pastors and rebuilding their call to lead others to Christ. We pray that the 120 pastors in attendance were encouraged and that there would be a spiritual awakening for the pastors in this area.
