**Testimonial Spotlight** My name is Y. Rathna Kumari. I have been a Bible Lady with IREF for the past 15 years, leading the IREF congregation and church of Nalluripallem when my father, Y. Koteswara Rao passed away. To share my testimony is a privilege and joy!

My father was born into a high-caste Hindu family. In 1955, he walked from Nalluripalem to Repalle (approximately a one hour trip by foot in those days due to no roads) to see a movie. He missed the first show, and decided to wait for the midnight showing since he had already gone that far. While he was waiting, he could hear singing from a distance and there was a light in the middle of the town that drew him in. My father spent the next two hours listening to Prasada Rao Rebba preach the Gospel. When it was time for the next showing of the movie, he went to the theatre, and walked home when the movie was done. Once he got home, he couldn't sleep. He kept hearing the words from the preaching over and over again. The next day, my father walked back to Repalle to hear Prasada Rao preach again, and immediately gave his life to Christ.

Being from a high-caste Hindu family, my father's conversion led to ostracization, and tremendous persecution from our extended family and village. But my parents stood firm in their faith.

There were 3 kids in our family at that time. My older sister, myself, our brother and then later, my parents had our youngest sister, who tragically passed away at the age of 14. In early 1982, my mother was diagnosed with Tuberculosis and passed away. A few years later, my brother passed away from Leukemia. Our struggles didn't pull us away from the Lord, in fact He drew us nearer to Him.

Like Joshua was to Moses, my father was to Prasada Rao. They walked village to village sharing the Gospel; praying with people, baptizing and leading them to Christ. They followed God's call to bring Light into the darkest of rural villages. My father was a farmer. He owned 4 acres of rice fields and used what God had blessed him with, to further the Kingdom. He gave many pounds of rice to IREF every year to feed the thousands of people who attended the Gospel Meetings each February. He served diligently, prayed without ceasing until the day he die.

The church in our village was built in over 30 years ago. Then fixed and rededicated almost 10 years ago by our kind friends from South Park Church in Illinois. Today, our congregation still meets regularly. Many young people who studied at IREF, now attend our church. It's a blessing to see the impact the Holy Spirit is making on our people thru IREF. The women in our village gather on Wednesdays and Saturdays to study the Word of God and to pray. Please join us in prayer. As I am getting older, I have a burden for the future generations. I know God will provide a good leader for our church. My father used to say that he had nothing to leave behind except for riches in Christ, I am thankful he did!
