In August, I had the privilege of traveling to the IREF campus for the first time in

my life. I have heard reports, read the newsletters, and hosted the leaders over the last ten years. Yet, I will never forget what I experienced in the town of Repalle.

Tre Moore, John Rebba, and Emmanuel Rebba invited me to join them in preaching at the Believer's Retreat. We encouraged the students and villagers to return to the Lord from Micah 3:7. By the end, after hours of praying, singing, and listening to God's Word, twenty-one students and villagers wanted to be baptized.

We drove some distance on a bumpy dirt road in a caravan of vehicles to the Krishna river. As the water buffalo watched and laborers gathered sand for sale, Hindus and one Muslim demonstrated that God heard our prayers as they took baptism. In their testimonies, some wept as they told us their parents didn't want them to take this step of faith. Yet they did. Those with Hindu names received Christian ones. All face government persecution and some will have to deal with family persecution.

Obedience to God is costly in India. Nevertheless, God is at work doing great things at IREF.
