Spotlight on Students Pavan and Nikhil fidgeted as they sat down to share their story with Dee Rebba and IREF-USA director, Tre Moore. As Dee asked about their family, Pavan looked away and scratched at his knee. Nikhil couldn't meet Dee or Tre's eyes either, so Dee quickly moved to the couch, squeezing between the two brothers. "You don't need to tell us your story," she said, "We care about you. We love you both."

Looking at Tre, she said, "Many times, students come from such difficult, heart-wrenching backgrounds. They leave what happened in the past, and they focus on the oasis of hope they've found at IREF."



She then turned to the brothers, changed the subject, and spoke only in Telugu. The boys giggled as they told stories about their time at IREF. They love the food, and they told Dee about their best friends and favorite subjects. Then, almost out of nowhere, Pavan slowly shared their story.

They were raised by their mother since their parents were divorced, but unfortunately, she was abusive. When the boys disobeyed, she put chili powder in their eyes, and to this day, Nikhil still has eyesight problems. After three years of mistreatment from their mother, they begged their father to help. He took them from her, and the brothers finally felt safe.

Last year, though, their father fell in love with a woman who didn't want Pavan and Nikhil. She told their father, "It's the two boys or me; you can't have both." Tears fell down his cheek as Pavan confessed, "My father chose her over us." Their father visits them at IREF every few months, but his decision cut deep into their soft hearts.

As the boys talked with Dee, they called her "Amma", which is Telugu for mom. And at the end of the conversation, their Amma gave them 40 rupees (50 cents) to buy a special treat. Pavan and Nikhil are grateful for IREF's hospitality and for things like three meals each day, new friends, non-abusive discipline, and an Amma.

Because of your generosity, children like Pavan and Nikhil experience a reality full of love and belonging. Many experience paternal love and care for the first time from Emmanuel and Dee Rebba. Please keep these precious boys and others in your prayers as they continue their education at IREF.
